



2011-2012 MI Learning Educator Stipend Information, Application Questions and Scoring Matrix

Apply for a Michigan educator stipend for creating quality learning resources for a new collection/topic on MI Learning on iTunes U. You may apply for one of the following stipends:

1. \$500.00 stipend (provide 10 enhanced or video resources)
2. \$1000.00 and free registration to the MACUL Conference (provide 20 enhanced, video resources. Some of these may be PDFs that support the learning.)

Applications will be accepted and reviewed in an ongoing basis through June 2012. The applicants who are selected must post resources by September 14, 2012.

Description of Learning Resources to be developed:

The curriculum resources being developed for distribution on MI Learning on iTunes U are enhanced podcasts (uses slides, photos, screen casts, etc.), video podcasts and PDFs that support the podcast content.

1. The selected educators agree to provide resources in one curriculum area (new collection or topic) at a particular level that help students learn or review the subject matter. For example: a series of enhanced or video resources on topics in core subject areas, or physical education, world languages, music, history. The content of these resources is based on the Michigan Curriculum Content Standards, Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCEs), or Common Core Standards, depending on grade level and content area.
2. Winners need to submit content for MI Learning by September 14, 2011. Stipends will be distributed after winner notifies the MI Learning Project Manager that their series is completed.

How to apply for the MI Learning Educator Stipend:

1. Visit iTunes U and explore K12 resources currently provided.
 - Navigate to K12 learning resources: iTunes > iTunes U > K12. You can also access Michigan's MI Learning on iTunes U through the link at <http://macul.org/milearning/>.

 - d. Upload one enhanced or video podcast sample to <http://207.75.209.246/milearningstipend/>. This learning resource will be reviewed according to the principles found in the *MI Learning Resource Evaluation* (*MI Learning Participation Information*, p.6).

1. Provide an overview of the content to be included in the enhanced or video podcasts you will be posting on MI Learning on iTunes U. Include the subject area, level, targeted audience, along with a description of the content of this collection. Maximum words: 300. **(20 points)**
 2. List five of the specific Michigan Curriculum Content Standards, Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCEs) or Common Core Standards that will be addressed in your series enhanced or video podcasts. **(10 points)**
 3. Provide a description for one enhanced or video podcast that you will upload for review. Include the Michigan Curriculum Content Standard(s), Grade Level Content Expectation(s) (GLCE), or Common Core Standard(s) that will be addressed. Briefly identify what kind of visuals will be included (photos, video content, slides, etc.) or other special elements. Maximum words: 300. **(15 points)**
 4. Identify how you plan to use the learning resources that you are creating. Maximum words: 50. **(10 points)**
 5. The awareness and support of your building administrator is important for this project. Did you inform the building administrator and do they support your involvement? **(5 points)**
